Film: The Legend of Tarzan

Discussion for a movie night: Enjoy the film. Afterwards, here are some discussion questions that might help you to engage with others on the topics from the film.
Enjoy the time engaging with the film, your faith and friends.



Film Synopsis

Deep in the heart of Africa, King Leopold of Belgium has sent his representative, Leon Rom (Christoph Waltz) to the Congo Free State to pillage the riches of this uncharted land. In the process, the monarch amasses huge debts to many countries of the world, but in particular to England and the United States. The English government decides to approach Lord John Clayton/Tarzan (Alexander Skarsgård) and ask him to go as their nation's representative to the Congo and survey the work of the Belgians and at the personal request of Rom. After some deliberation, John Clayton decides to go back to his former homeland accompanied by his wife, Jane (Margot Robbie), and an American government representative, George Washington Williams (Samuel L. Jackson). The trio searches out and eventually combats the crimes that the King Leopold's troops and Rom are committing against humanity and nature in this reclusive African nation. The battle ensues with the aid of his human and animal families, and Tarzan must come to terms with his past and assist the people of the Congo to save their future.
